



COVID-19 Screening questions	Yes	No
<p>Do you or any member of your household/family have a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 diagnosed in the last 14 days?</p> <p>NB: Any person who has previously tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 by PCR should be exempt from being re-tested within a period of 90 days from their initial symptom onset, or the first positive test, if asymptomatic, unless they develop new possible COVID-19 symptoms. This is because fragments of inactive virus can be persistently detected by PCR in respiratory tract samples for some time following infection.</p>		
Do you or any member of your household/family have suspected COVID-19 and are waiting for a COVID-19 test result?		
Have you travelled internationally in the last 10 days to a country that is on the Government red list?		
Have you had contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19, or been in isolation with a suspected case in the last 10 days?		
<p>Do you have any of the following symptoms?</p> <p>High temperature or fever? New, continuous cough? A loss or alteration to taste or smell?</p>		

General respiratory screening questions	Yes	No
Do you have any new or worsening respiratory symptoms not already mentioned which suggest you may have a respiratory virus? (¹ See note below)		
Have you been had a laboratory test with a confirmed respiratory virus/infection such as Influenza in the last 14 days? ²
